

Accreditation

The AP Degree in Financial Management provides access to bachelor programmes at a range of universities in Denmark and abroad, where you will be able to acquire a Bachelor's Degree in 1-1 ½ years. You will also have access to the 1-year BA (Hons) Business Administration programme offered in Copenhagen by De Montfort University and Niels Brock.

Another possibility of achieving a Bachelor's Degree in Denmark is a BSc in Economics and Business Administration from Handelshøjskolecentret. The programme will be provided at Niels Brock.

Admission Criteria

1. A general upper secondary education from Denmark/Scandinavia (Upper Secondary School Leaving Examination, Higher Commercial Examination, Higher Technical Examination or Higher Preparatory Examination)
2. The International and the European Baccalaureate
3. High school diplomas from the United States followed by at least one year of university or college studies in relevant subjects. This also applies to applicants with a high school diploma from countries with a similar system
4. At least two years of studies in relevant subjects from universities in African countries, Bangladesh, India, Pakistan and the Philippines, or from countries with a similar educational system
5. A Danish vocational education supplemented with English level B and with Mathematics or Business Economics level B
6. Other appropriate education found to be acceptable at the discretion of Niels Brock Business Academy

In order to be admitted to the programme students must have good and well-documented qualifications in:

- English
International students must have taken an internationally approved English test, e.g. TOEFL paper based test score of 550+ or computer based test score of 213+ or IELTS academic score of 6.0+ or a total APIEL score of 3+. Danish students must have at least level B.
- Mathematics or Business Economics
Danish students must have at least level B (equivalent to 2-3 years of studies on upper-secondary level). International students must hold a certificate proving adequate qualifications.

Course fees

Tuition is free for students from the Nordic/EU/EEA countries. For other students the tuition fee is DKK 32,500 (approx. Euro 4,350) per semester, in all DKK 130,000 (approx. Euro 8,700)

The AP Degree in Financial Management

The Professional Profile

The AP degree in Financial Management is a 2-year full-time undergraduate programme taught in English. The programme was developed in 2005 based on research into the demands of the business world for staff with international competences in the area of finance.

The escalating globalisation of the 21st century demand, that employees are well-informed about the complexity of the international economic situation and the financial opportunities. Client counselling requires up-to-date know-how and the ability to carry out tasks with a broad perspective and in cooperation with people of different cultural and educational backgrounds.

Financial Management graduates communicate and collaborate well, they are well-organised with a global view, they are analytical and employ efficient methods in a multitude of relations and they are able to work independently.

Instruction is based on relevant business practices and combine practice and theory. Issues related to various types of enterprises within the financial sector are included as well as financial management of private and public companies.

The purpose of the educational programme is to make you qualified to work independently with the planning, organisation and realisation of tasks within finance, investments, insurance, real estate and administration of property.

Heading for a job in International Financial Management

The AP Degree in Financial Management provides you with appropriate qualifications so that you can work with financial consultancy for example

- in a bank
- at mortgage institution
- in an insurance company
- at a real estate broker's
- at a real estate administrator's
- in the finance department of a large private or public enterprise.



Structure of the programme

The educational programme consists of a compulsory part and an elective part. The compulsory part constitutes 90 ECTS and the elective part 30 ECTS

Teaching and learning approaches of the programme are based on themes. This means that all subjects are interconnected via a joint inter-disciplinary semester theme. This is done in order to link the individual subject elements and thus create a more holistic view.

Compulsory part (90 ECTS):

1st semester: Introduction to Finance and Methodology

2nd semester: The Financial Sector and Society

3rd semester: Financial Counselling of Business/Corporate Customers

Thematic modules are organised on the basis of the following subjects:

- Financial markets and enterprises
- Personal economics
- Customer/client relations
- Business Economics
- Management and communications
- Global Economics
- Business Law
- Statistics

Elective part (30 ECTS)

The elective part consists of two elements where you will have the opportunity to customise your 4th semester to meet your individual needs:

4th semester:

Specialisation and Final Examination Project

- Work placement or specialised courses in Denmark or abroad
- Final examination project in Denmark or abroad

Students may utilise the numerous contacts offered by Niels Brock to universities in e.g. the US, the Nordic countries, and most EU countries.
